FAFSA Walkthrough

Available after October 1. This presentation will provide a step-by-step instruction for completing the FAFSA, with actual screen shots from the FAFSA website. The goal is to familiarize students and their families the FAFSA. This is not a “hands- on” FAFSA completion event. Families requiring additional assistance can schedule an appointment for a one-on-one session with our experts. Time: 45-60 minutes

FAFSA Completion Assistance

Available beginning October 1. This is a “hands-on” one-on-one session with one of Stand by Me’s FAFSA experts. It will provide students and their families with actual, real-time assistance in completing the FAFSA. Students and their families will be directed to schedule 1-hour time slots for individual FAFSA assistance via Zoom. Time: 1-hour appointments.

Paying for College-For Juniors

Available after April 1. This is an overview of options for paying for college (see above). The goal is to make students and their parents aware of financial aid as they approach their senior year. Students of all grades and their families are encouraged to attend. Time: 45-60 minutes.
