

INDIAN RIVER SCHOOL DISTRICT CODE OF CONDUCT/PENALTIES

The IRSD has official, written policies and procedures that identify and provide legal and detailed descriptions and definitions of specific offenses and acts of misconduct. The following list of offenses may not be all-inclusive and the accompanying descriptions are not intended to be complete, legal definitions. The administration has the discretion to use any or all of the listed penalties under each offense as a guideline or substitute any other consequence due to misconduct within or on school property, and at school sponsored or supervised activities, including school grounds, school buses, and school functions (on and off campus).

ATTORNEY GENERAL REPORT: Delaware Department of Justice reports of out of school criminal conduct. All off campus, non-school activity conduct which shows disregard for the health, safety, and welfare of others including, but not limited to, violence, weapons, and drug offenses may subject a student to disciplinary action as indicated in the code of conduct. BUS VIOLATIONS: Any violation of school bus regulations or acts of misconduct that takes place on the school bus. While in transport all school rules are in effect; the bus driver is the staff person in charge. Some examples of disorderly conduct are confrontational physical contact, fighting, verbal abuse, threats, or obscenities, and failure to disperse. FIRE ALARM/BOMB THREATS: Illegally activating an alarm or an alarm system. Illegally communicating a bomb or explosive device threat either verbally or in writing. Also an illegal act as defined by Delaware State Law. (A legal investigation of, or arrest for illegally activating an alarm system or communicating a bomb or explosive device threat.) HARRASSMENT: shall mean any actions or statements made with the intent to harass, annoy, or alarm another person which: A) insults, taunts, or challenges the other person or; B) is a cause of alarming or distressing conduct which serves no legitimate purpose and is done in a manner which the actor knows is likely to provoke a violent or disorderly response or cause a reasonable person to suffer fear, alarm, or distress. TEEN DATING VIOLENCE: shall mean assaultive, threatening or controlling behavior, including stalking as defined in 11 Del.C. §1312, that one person uses against another person in order to gain or maintain power or control in a current or past relationship.
