The Indian River School District will host two public meetings for senior citizens during the month of January. The purpose of the meetings is to explain the district's upcoming referendum and to highlight the various tax assistance programs available to seniors.

The major capital improvement and current expense referendum is scheduled for Tuesday, February 5. The initiative will seek funding for the construction of a new Sussex Central High School, an eight-classroom addition at Indian River High School and a four-classroom addition at Selbyville Middle School. Residents will also be asked to approve funding for staff, curriculum, supplies, transportation and utility expenses for a high school and elementary school.
