IRSD will address learning loss by employing teachers and purchasing goods and services that include, but are not limited to, digital curriculum, Reading and Math interventionists, and instructional coaches. Effectiveness will be assessed via observation and analysis of student assessment data. In addition, effectiveness will be assessed through written evaluations of staff members. IRSD will provide compensatory students to special education students who were unable to receive services during the COVID-19 school closures. Effectiveness will be assessed by reconciling the compensatory services that were not provided during the 2019-2020 school year to the compensatory services provided once reopening occurs. IRSD will employee hourly paraprofessionals to support schools with operational, instruction, and social-emotional needs as schools fully reopen. Effectiveness will be assessed through analysis of student data. IRSD will provide summer school programming that will focus on accelerating learning for participating students such as the use of preview to prepare for the future school years and interventions to fill the unfinished learning gaps. This will also include cost of transportation. Effectiveness will be assessed through observation and student assessment data.

IRSD will continue to employ 2 itinerant nurses that will gather data, assess, and respond to COVID-19 exposures throughout the district. Effectiveness will be assessed by observation of district response.
