Major Capital Planning

Mr. Steele reviewed with the Board and the public various options for the district regarding major capital planning.

- Option #1
 - New elementary school (Ingrams Pond), new middle school, renovations to Sussex Central High School and additions to Selbyville Middle and Indian River High School with an estimated local share cost of \$71,882,552.00.
- Option #2
 - New high school (2200 students), additions to Selbyville Middle School and Indian River High School with an estimated local share cost of \$51,806,893.60.
- Option #3
 - New elementary school (Ingrams Pond), new middle school, new high school (1200 students) additions to Selbyville Middle and Indian River High School with an estimated local share cost of \$58,105,487.60.
- Option #4
 - New elementary school (Ingrams Pond), new middle school, 9th grade academy at Sussex Central High School and Indian River High School, additions to Selbyville Middle School with an estimated local share cost of \$53,048,292.40.

• Option #5

o New elementary school (Ingrams Pond), new high school (2200 students), additions to Selbyville Middle School and Indian River High School with an estimated local share cost of \$62,974,438.80.
